

Checklist for **POST** Isolation Room Cleaning Process

Important Note:

*Soiled PPE and isolation trash can be disposed of in doubled, sturdy trash bags, tied closed in the routine trash removal.

*Saturated, soaked or potentially leaking PPE and isolation trash must be red bagged and disposed of using medical waste removal. ResCare has a national contract with Stericycle for this.

Perform hand hygiene	Wash hands in accordance with infection control protocol			
Step 1 Prepare for isolation cleaning	Don PPE per Company Infection Control Policy and Procedure			
Step 2 Collect trash and soiled linens	Remove soiled linens, place in laundry bag Collect trash (See important note on bagging and disposal)			
Step 3 Clean and disinfect room. Disinfect all surfaces with EPA Disinfectant Cleaner appropriate for that particular surface.	Doorknobs/handles Door surface Mattress / Pillows Bedside rails Bed frame Table Drawers (inside & out) TV Light switches Other Furniture Chair, arms, seat back Windowsills, blinds			
Step 4 Clean and disinfect bathroom (starting with highest surfaces first)	Mirror Lights Sink Counter tops Faucets (at sink) Bathroom handrails Tub/shower Toilet level/flush Toilet horizontal surface/seat Commode Windows, blinds			
Step 5 Mop room and prepare to exit.	Dust-mop tile first Wet-mop tile after dust mop Visually inspect room and ensure all surfaces have been cleaned and disinfected Disinfect cleaning equipment, i.e. mop handles / bucket handles Remove PPE and dispose of trash (See important note on bagging and disposal) Perform hand hygiene Make bed
